

# Information for Parents

- CAMP FEE** The Summer Camp 2010 @ Phoebe Needles fee is \$180.00. In addition to lodging, meals, supervision and program each camper receives, the camp fee includes a camp picture, T-shirt and all craft supplies. A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit is due with your registration materials. The balance of the fee is due two weeks before the camp session begins. Please note that space is limited to 35 teens per session, so register early.
- SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE** It is our hope to make Summer Camp 2010 @ Phoebe Needles available to all teens without respect to ability to pay. Financial assistance in the form of a scholarship is available from The Phoebe Needles Center. Contact the Office Manager for more information.
- PHILOSOPHY** The Phoebe Needles Center is committed to the principles of equal opportunity, and makes its programs and employment opportunities available to all people without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age or national origin.
- HEALTH & SAFETY** For the health and safety of every camper, The Phoebe Needles Center must have a current medical information form on file for each camper. Prescription or necessary, routine medications will be dispensed only by a member of the Phoebe Needles staff. Over-the-counter medications and first aid supplies will be provided by the Center, if needed.
- DO NOT BRING** Pets, candy, firearms, fireworks, knives, alcohol, non-prescription drugs, personal stereos, hand-held electronic games, **cell phones**, or tobacco of any kind are not allowed. The Phoebe Needles Center will not be responsible for jewelry or other valuables.
- ARRIVAL** Program registration is from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. on the first day of the session. In case of delay in arrival or last-minute cancellation, please notify the Director at (540) 483-1518 or (800) 848-1677. We are not able to accommodate early arrivals.
- DEPARTURE** The Summer Camp 2010 @ Phoebe Needles ends at 11:00 a.m. on the last day of camp. Participants should be picked up at that time. Our staff needs some well-deserved rest between sessions. Arrangements for early departure must be made in advance or during registration on the first day as they are disruptive to the camp program.
- MAIL** You are welcome to write your youth while at camp. The mailing address is 732 Turners Creek Road, Callaway, VA, 24067. Please do not send food to your camper, other than home-baked goodies which will be shared immediately with others. All other food items such as packaged candy and gum will be sent home with your camper. Please do not send any money or other valuables.
- TELEPHONE** Your youth is not accessible by phone unless it is an emergency. It is very disruptive for many youth to have a phone call from a parent during camp.
