Gene Herrick will present “What Would Martin Luther King, Jr. Say?”

Mr. Herrick will be discussing his experiences with Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. He will also be interpreting the current Civil Rights Movement through Dr. King’s lens.

Gene E. Herrick was a photographer and writer with the Associated Press for 28 years throughout the 1940’s to the 1970’s. He has covered many national political events, including five presidents of the United States and the major league sports of tennis, baseball, football, and golf. Additionally, Herrick covered the beginning of the Civil Rights Movement, including the Emmitt Till murder case, Autherine Lucky being kicked out of the University of Alabama, and the Rosa Parks story. He also covered the beginning and rise of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his assassination in Memphis in 1968. Herrick was also a War Correspondent during the 1950’s Korean War.
